### CD CHECKLIST

Our fun-fly events are generally run by a CD or Contest Director. It might be that the CD is new to the events and has never run one before or perhaps one of you out there would like to be a CD but your not sure what all you'd have to do. If you decide to run a contest as the CD here a checklist that covers the basics for you so it won't feel foreign.

- Dates: Check for the fun-fly date and time
- Notify - you can notify someone you want the event
- Event Helpers: Determine how many helpers you think you will need and line them up. Consider management of any tickets, frequency controls, food, etc.
- Event Rules: Keep a notebook containing the official rules and go back to this after the event to make notes on what did and did not work for the event.
- Whiteboard: use a whiteboard with markers to keep scores for each event.
- Cell Phone: Don't forget to have a way to contact other members for info - program in their numbers ahead of time
- Awards - If any
- PA System if you have it or someone with a loud voice

This is a great chance to get to know the other members of the club and provide the ability to come up with some crazy contests for everyone to have fun with. Be sure to sign up to be CD at one of the fun-fly's.
